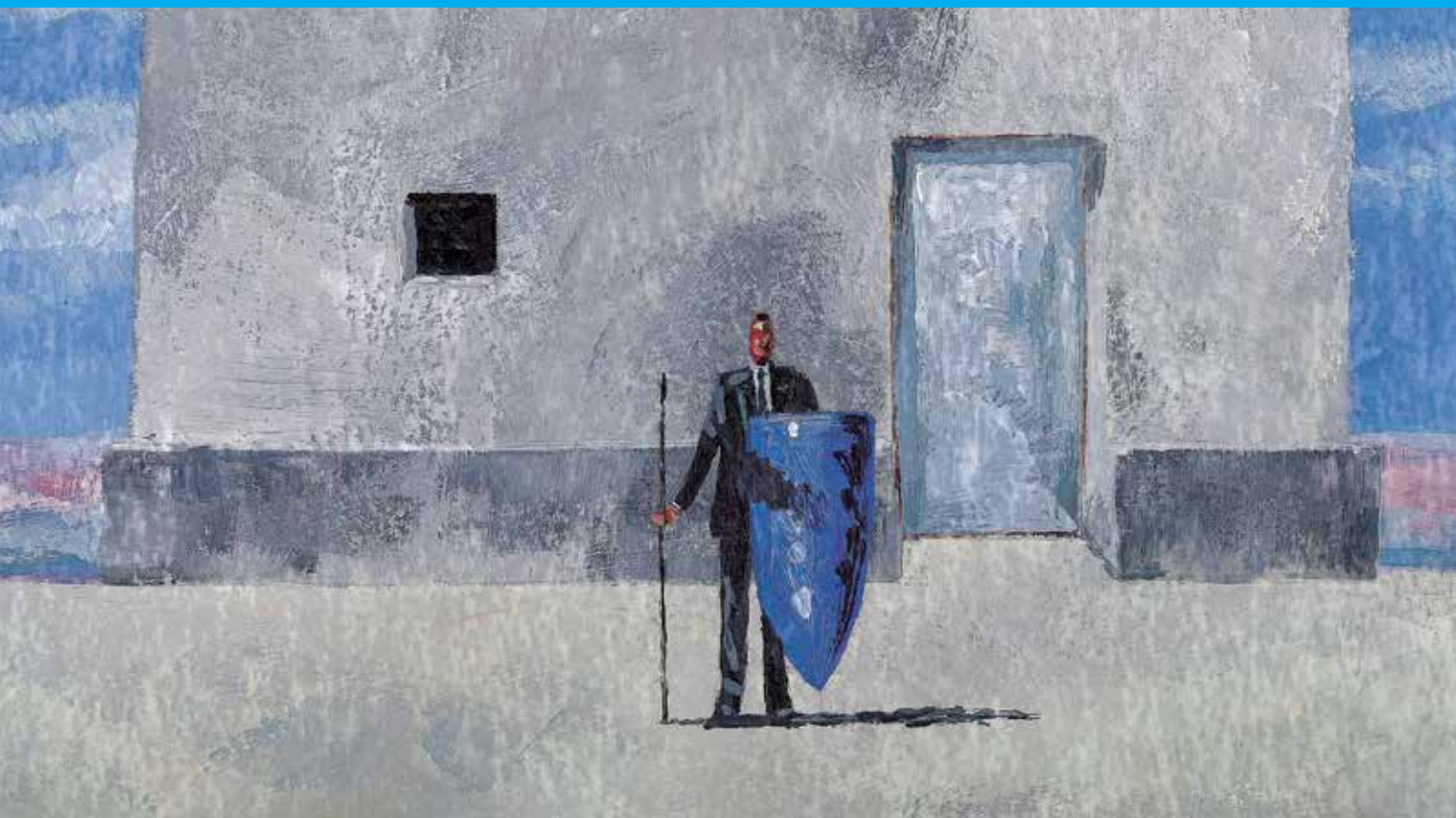

- 2. Understand process safety management effectiveness** - including evaluating why major accidents occur and the associated costs, key risk control systems and their importance in managing risks, the impact of good practice guidance, integrated management systems and policy deployment.
- 3. Understand process safety accountability** - including the importance of fostering a positive process safety culture and how open communications should take place between board and principal shareholders.
